SUMER switched to detector B which works normally and will need some trimming in order to deal with intense lines. Good spectra for both JOPs Detailed analysis will be possible.

CDS identified a bright point associated with a plume in the CH approaching sun center. Features identified in line ratios sensitive to temperature (hot BP cool Plume) and FIP effect. JOP 102 should work.

EIT identified a monster CME between 1800 UT and 1900 UT due to apparently temporarily corrupted data in the QKL data base. The fever has dropped.

Some small ejecta all day from AR 8545 Small filament eruption in the NW at 2000 UT

This morning fair size CME from AR 8545 producing noticeable dimming at 0900 UT.

Pic du Midi was in severe weather condition : snow and no helicopter.

Fair weather expected at the Pic this weekend (no EIT !)
